2017-2018 CLUB BUDGET OVERVIEW

Heather Logelin provided a riveting overview of our club's annual budget for the 2017-2018 Rotary year, which started 07/01/17 and will end 06/30/18. Here is the high level budget summary, followed by more detailed breakdowns:

\$26,900 Operating income
\$41,000 Fundraising income *
 \$67,900 TOTAL INCOME
 \$26,351 Operating expenses
\$14,000 Fundraising expenses
\$40,351 TOTAL EXPENSES
\$27,549 NET INCOME [*This is the money we budgeted to spend on programs and projects!*]

* Does not include individual Member contributions to (1) The Rotary Foundation and (2) The Backpack Program.

OPERATING BUDGET

\$26,400 = Quarterly membership dues (\$115 or \$55)
\$500 = New member application fees (\$100)
 \$26,900 = TOTAL OPERATING INCOME
 \$10,200 = Club breakfasts
 \$4,766 = Rotary International annual dues (\$79.43/member)
 \$3,120 = Rotary District 5960 annual dues (\$52.00/member)
 \$3,325 = Rotary conferences & trainings
 \$2,325 = Bookkeeping, accounting & tax filings
\$2,615 = Club Runner, Tidings, Sneak Peak, badges, t-shirts, etc.
\$26,351 = TOTAL OPERATING EXPENSES
\$549 = TOTAL OPERATING NET INCOME [*In other words, our dues pay for our expenses, with little left over!*]

FUNDRAISING BUDGET

\$4,000 = Happy Bucks
 \$19,000 = Food Booths
 \$14,000 = Gala
\$4,000 = Relay for Life
 \$41,000 = TOTAL FUNDRAISING INCOME
 \$5,000 = Food Booth Expenses
 \$6,000 = Gala Expenses
\$3,000 = Relay for Life Expenses
\$14,000 = TOTAL FUNDRAISING EXPENSES
\$27,000 = TOTAL FUNDRAISING NET INCOME [*Again, this is the money we spend on programs and projects!*]

Heather also provided an overview of spending on club projects and programs – and on other Rotary-related projects and programs – noting that we still have plans to make a significant investment in Glen Park. Questions? Let Heather know!
